- A Message from Pastor Trish -

This month our focus is on stewardship, with the theme of “You Have Heard It Said – Making Sense of Faith and Finances”. Stewardship is a common theme, especially every fall as we begin to think about building a church budget for the coming year and we ask people to consider making a financial pledge, check on their giving for the current year, etc. It ends up sounding like a lot of “business and busy” work, doesn’t it? It’s easy to assume that stewardship means “the annual reminder from the church that they need money”.

BUT – that’s really NOT what stewardship is, of course. Stewardship first and foremost is about – LOVE. (Is that what you were expecting me to write?) Stewardship is about looking down, as we recognize and remember how God comes down to us in love, especially with the life, death and resurrection of Christ. Stewardship is also about looking in, as we ponder all that God has entrusted to our care and tending. Finally, stewardship is about looking out, and we consider the myriad ways in which God calls us to show love to our neighbor. Ultimately, stewardship is about living out the greatest commandments of loving God, and loving neighbor. We do so with our time, our skills (talents) and our treasure (money).

In his book “Giving to God” Mark Alan Powell says that we are invited to put money in the offering plate on Sunday morning (or these days, set up an automatic withdrawal!) not because the church needs our money, but because we want and need to give it. Go back and read that sentence again, would you? In the kingdom of God, the giving of our money doesn’t happen because the church (or any other organization) needs it. Instead, we give because we have a spiritual need to worship God, and through our offerings, we are able to express our love and devotion for God in a way that is simple and sincere.

So here’s the question for you to ponder – how does your giving express your love and devotion to God? Are there changes you want or need to make to express this love? And secondly, how does your giving express love to your neighbor? Again, are there changes that you want or need to make to better express this love to your neighbor?

When you start to ask those questions, then it also becomes reasonable to start asking how that gift is being spent. For example, where does your giving to Messiah go? It pays for my salary of course, and for the other staff, and for the musicians on Sunday and materials for education and worship and for building upkeep and utilities....and it also goes to care for our neighbors. It goes off to the larger church for their work and especially, for the missions of the church. It also goes to community organizations – such spending is a part of the church budget and every few months the council makes a determination on where to send our benevolence; often sending it to a variety of community partners and non-profits. Sometimes you are making donations of winter clothing, bringing food items for blizzard bags and food shelves, offering groceries that are made into meals for hungry college students or homeless folk. Your giving reaches dozens of people in dozens of ways. Want another example? Think about how your giving supports my work when I lead worship at assisted living facilities, or make a hospital visit or bring communion to someone at home.

This month, we will “hear it said” as we discern what scripture says about stewardship and finances and more. Come, learn, ponder, discern, give!

Reformation Sunday—October 29th

There is lots happening on Reformation Sunday at Messiah this year!

- It’s a 5th Sunday, so we will have a Messiah Worship United Service at 10 AM. OF COURSE there will be lots of great music, including the choir, and OF COURSE we will sing “A Mighty Fortress” with a brass choir!
- We will celebrate communion a bit differently! Some of have requested an opportunity to chare in the sacrament around the table (altar) so we will try it out that day, as well as use communion cups as opposed to intinction.
- Pledge cards for 2024 will be able to be returned as we wrap up our emphasis on stewardship.
- Sunday School families! Come early for a FAMILY Sunday School lesson on Reformation that day with Pastor Trish!

Not quite sure what’s the big deal about Reformation Sunday? It’s the day we remember how Martin Luther nailed his 95 Theses to the door of the Wittenberg church in 1517, an act that led to the Reformation/Protestant movement. It’s a long-standing holiday, and it’s a day we especially celebrate our understanding that we are saved by grace alone through faith.

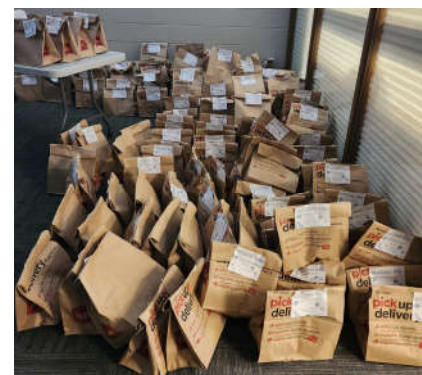
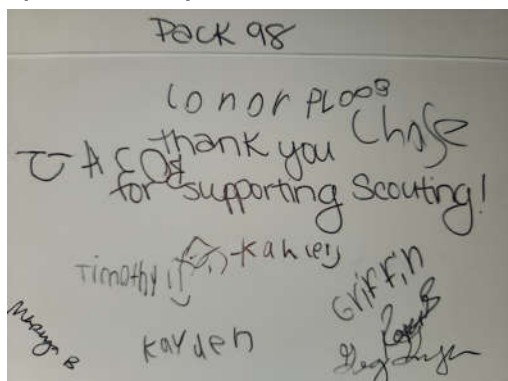
Thanks Yous

From the Church Council ...

—September Highlights—

Stewardship & Finance: As of August 30, we have fallen behind the past two years' average for the first time. We are at 61% of budget compared to 62%, and are down \$2,000 in giving from the average. Year-to-date, we have spent \$19,660 on snow removal compared to an average of \$7,192 for the last 2 years.

Adopt-a-Hwy is planned for October 1st. Christmas Eve worship was approved from 10:30 am, 2:30 pm, and 4:30 pm. Christmas Day worship will be at 9:00 am. The anti-racism team will start meeting again in October.

Council is asking for changes to scholarship awards and have sent recommendations to Endowment team. A capital campaign for \$40,000 is being planned for early 2024, for parking lot and furnace updates.

Next council meeting will be Sunday, October 15th at 11:30 am.
