- A Message from LaDonna Thomas -

Dear Beloved People of Messiah,



How is it with your soul?

We are being asked to hold an awful lot in these days. One of the ways to cope in the midst of things we cannot change or control is to stay grounded in our identity as beloved children of God and to allow our connection to God to be an anchor to hold us in chaotic times. I have a number of spiritual practices that help me stay grounded. They are called "practices" for a reason – no one ever perfects them. We're all practicing. I don't practice them all in a given day, but my "spiritual tool box" has enough practices in it that if one or two don't resonate on given day, I have others I can try.

I share a few of mine here, with the encouragement that if you don't have a spiritual practice or two, you might try a few of these:

- 1. Centering Prayer for at least 15 minutes (this is akin to a meditation practice, but it's goal is not enlightenment as much as it is awareness of the presence of God).
- 2. Lectio Divina a way of reading passages of Scripture listening for a word or phrase that resonates and then seeing what gifts it offers.
- 3. Worship in community with others
- 4. Listening to music (for me mostly choral or instrumental)
- 5. A yoga practice (helps regulate my breathing and grounding my body)
- 6. Walking or riding a bike outside
- 7. Take breaks during the day to just breathe and be in the present moment.

None of these practices will solve the troubles of the world, but they take care of me and my soul. They ground me and when I am spiritually grounded, I am more grounded emotionally and cognitively. When I am spiritually grounded, when it is well with my soul, I can more faithfully wrestle with the question "What is mine to do?"

How is it with your soul? What's keeping you connected to the God of the universe, who loves you deeply, and who desires that love not only fill your life, but overflow into a world that is in desperate need of it?


Thursday Men's Bible Study

COUNCIL UPDATES

2025 council members: Janet Jones, Nate Brekke, Jean Zandstra, Katie Hendrickson, Dustin Runkle, Swede Mundell, Julie Olsen and Greg Suskovic.

Our August tithes and offerings were \$27,386 (5 weeks) vs expenses of \$29,858. This left us short by \$2,472 for the month. Income YTD 2025 is \$236,695 with expenses at \$239,201 or a minor shortfall of \$2507. Income YTD 2024 was \$218,176 vs. expenses of \$229,744 which left us at a \$11,568 deficit. Therefore, our giving is \$18,000 above last year while expenses are \$10,000 higher. We look forward to celebrating our successful capital campaign on the 28th!

Church Council met on July 23rd and the following was discussed:

- We continue to need musical support on Wednesday nights. Contact Pastor LaDonna if you know of someone who might be interested.
- Funding for permanent name tags is still being sought.
- Pictorial directories can soon be requested as a PDF or paper copy.
- A constitutional update is in progress. Watch for more information on this.
- Messiah's monthly benevolences will go to the following: October Crossroads; November MACV (MN Assistance Council for Veterans); December A Fresh Start.
- An Honorarium will be given to Jade Hengel Photography for her work on Messiah's Welcome video.
- The council reviewed papers written by scholarship recipients. They included good insights about faith formation.
- The Annual meeting date will be Sunday, February 1, 2026, and we will have a Worships United Service that day.


