Dear Partners in the Gospel,

Stewardship & Finance: As of September 30, our giving is at 68% of budget vs. 70% of the last 2 years' average and are behind \$7,000 from projections. Fortunately, we have 5 Sundays in October and the fourth quarter is typically our biggest season of giving. We thank God that our snow season has not begun yet.

This past month, the council has met with the synod and the new interim pastor that will start mid-November. Decisions regarding a capital campaign for early 2024 are also in progress.


