- A Message from LaDonna Thomas -

Dear Beloved People of Messiah,

In my young adult life I lived fairly close to the Pacific Ocean and often camped there with friends. I can still remember one of those trips when the night sky was extraordinarily clear. After the campfire had been extinguished and the lights went out in the houses on the distant skyline, the number and expanse of stars visible to the naked eye was incredible! From horizon to horizon there were glistening dots and glowing planets. And there was me, a small speck on the sandy beach. In that moment, I recalled that the elements in my own body are the same elements of the stars that burst forth at creation eons ago. I was speechless and caught up in a moment of incredible awe at the creative power of the God of the universe!

God has made us and knit us together with a capacity to be awed. For me, it's that feeling or sense I have when I recognize that I am a small part of something that is bigger than just myself. That something bigger is God.

That experience often happens for me in nature. But it has also happened in an art gallery, at an airport, and in the



midst of a choral concert, to name a few. Just a couple of weeks ago I was at the Minnesota Museum of American Art where I saw this piece of art. The artist, Maggie Thompson (fond du lac Ojibwe) in her piece, Quantum Entanglement reflects on the intimate vulnerability and deep bonds that come from the "spiritual physics of heart-soul connections." Despite their intangibility and fragility, the connection between two hearts is real.

I have experienced that "heart-soul connections" with those I love, and maybe you have, too. To then see it depicted in art was also an experience of awe for me.

Now, add to this God-given capacity of awe the recent discoveries of neuroscientists. They have discovered that when people experience a sense of awe, it calms anxious minds. Experiences of awe bring a sense of wholeness and healing, they can instill hope, love, compassion, and empathy.

We and the world we live in could certainly use a good dose of those benefits! Like many of you, I am weary of the hatred, violence, and divisions that are all around us. A brief reading of the morning news often stirs up a mixture of sadness, anger, disbelief, and despair. Which makes experiences of awe, all the more important as antidotes and safeguards against getting stuck in those life-sapping feelings.

During the months of July and August our worship services will follow the theme "Purveyors of Awe." Purveyor is not a word we use much these days, but it has a sense of being one who has a storehouse of something unique of valuable that is made available to others. Each week we'll hear the invitations of scripture to experience awe through a sense of beauty, wonder, meaning, curiosity, delight, connection or self-giving. We'll suggest practices that you might try out during the week to receive your own "storehouse of awesome experiences." Beginning July 16th, you can join a group of us who will take an evening walk/hike to receive some awesome experiences of God's creation.

I think you'll find these weekly themes to be a fresh experience of spiritual life that fits well with summer times and it's more relaxed and leisurely life-style. Many of us will already be in settings that lend themselves to becoming "Purveyors of Awe."

COUNCIL UPDATES

Through May 2025 our tithes and offerings equal \$151,243 compared to \$145,133 this time last year. We have approximately 2 months left of our 2024-year end pre-giving. Expenses are at \$148,784 vs. \$140,831 in 2024. Therefore, our giving is \$6,110 above last year while expenses are \$7,953 higher. We continue to glorify God for what he has provided us and Messiah's response to his graciousness.

Church Council met on June 11th and the following was discussed:


- The Council has decided to launch a Capital Campaign. A congregational meeting will be on June 29th after 10 am worship to obtain support and approval from the congregation.
- A family in our community requires a car for transportation. If you have a car to donate or sell for a modest price, please contact the church office.
- Messiah's third quarter benevolences will be allocated to CADA, Theresa House, and My Place.
- A computer has been purchased & will be set up soon. This will enhance our church service streaming on Facebook.
- Messiah will install an automatic water meter reader.
- A dolly will be acquired for the safe transportation of the grand piano.
- Our worship band represented Messiah at the SEMN Synod Assembly, and Rev. Regina Hassanally was re-elected as Synod Bishop.
- The new program Gather is starting successfully. Join us on Wednesday mornings for fellowship and activities.

The next council meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, July 23rd at 6:30 pm.




Congregational Book Read—Coming Fall 2025
