“God’s work. Our hands.” Sunday



September 10th is “God’s Work Our Hands” Sunday in which we celebrate 10 years of an ELCA churchwide day of service. On this day (or another day as chosen by the congregation) ELCA members participate in service to their communities in as many ways as you can imagine – cleaning parks, packing or serving food, painting/restoring, kits for LWR.....

Here at Messiah we have periodically participated in this day of service – last year we made personal care kits for Lutheran World Relief. This year, we will again participate, and we need your help! We will be making “blizzard bags” for Meals on Wheels recipients who are served by VINE Faith in Action and Lutheran Social Services. These bags are given to recipients when winter weather is expected, and volunteer drivers are likely not going to be able to make their regular stops. We have set a VERY lofty goal of making at least 100 bags – and 150 would be even better so that we can get a bag to as many recipients as possible. Here’s how you can help:

Collect and bring in the food items we will need:

- Cans of chicken or tuna
- 14-15 oz. cans of fruit
- 12-15 oz. cans of vegetables or vegetable soup
- Small, snack size packages of crackers – saltines, or cheese and crackers or peanut butter and crackers
- Packages of hot chocolate – single serving sizes
- Desserts – pre-packaged granola bars, pudding cups, or individually packaged cookies

We will collect these items until Tuesday, September 5th and package them together onto our “blizzard bags” on Sunday the 10th after our Messiah Worships United Service.

But wait – there’s more! That day we will also be decorating birthday cards for children who participate in Camp Noah. Camp Noah is run by LSS and is a specially designed camping experience and curriculum for children who have experienced a disaster in their community. All supplies provided for this project – just come and decorate!

Rally Sunday and Fall Music Festival

September 10th is Rally Sunday as well as the Fall Music Festival; which will include the band, pianist, organist, flutist, bell choir, choir and other singers. Messiah will worship united at 10:00 am and join in a back-to-school blessing. After worship, the congregation will do a service project together as well as the Sunday School children will work on a special project. Registration forms will be available for Middle School Ministries and Sunday school.

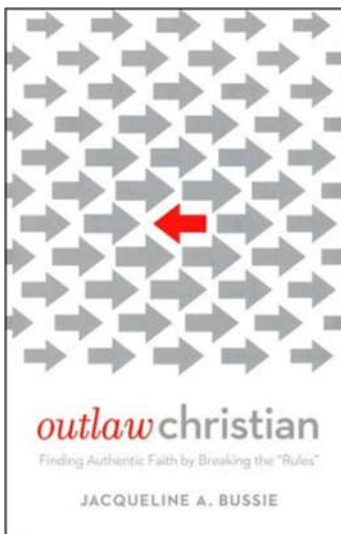
Elsewhere in this newsletter you can read about the opportunity to join a small group and together, read and discuss the book “Outlaw Christian: Finding Authentic Faith By Breaking the Rules” by Jacqueline Bussie. I decided to take this space to tell you more about the book, because it’s such a great read!

The book is easy to read in manageable chunks, organized around six different “unspoken rules” about a life of faith that Bussie argues should be broken. Those rules are: #1 never get angry at God #2 never doubt #3 never question #4 never tell your real story #5 always speak in cliches about evil and suffering and #6 always believe hope comes easy for those who truly believe in God. Bussie combines personal experience and story in making the case that these “rules” are obstacles to an authentic and realistic faith. In addition, she offers concrete and practical ideas for combating the rules, in order to “cultivate hope, seek joy, practice accompaniment, compost your pain and discover the spiritual practice of lament.”

I’ve found this book so helpful that I’ve used it as a basis for one of the units I teach for Middle School Ministries. I call the unit “Asking Hard Questions” and over the course of a few weeks we look at a few of these areas, including asking “can I get angry at God?” and “if God is good, why is there suffering?”. I’m also confident that no matter where you are in your own life of faith, you will find passages that will resonate for you, and it’s sure to spark lively and important discussion in the small groups that will be forming this fall.

Bussie is currently the Executive Director of the Collegeville Institute in St. Joseph, MN. Prior to that she spent a number of years at Concordia College, Moorhead teaching religion and theology classes as well as serving as Director of the Forum on Faith and Life. She’s had more than her share of personal heartache prior to and since this book was written, so she writes with a theological mind with words that definitely come from the heart. I’ve had the pleasure of hearing her speak a couple of times, and her authenticity is apparent in her speaking as well as her writing. I hope you’ll consider “Outlaw Christian” as one of your next reads!

Book Study and Small Group Sign-ups



Last year at this time you were offered an opportunity to participate in a small group book study. Two different groups met monthly for approximately 6 months to read and discuss, and get to know one another better. Those who have participated want to do it again, and you are invited to once again join a small group for learning and fellowship! The book that has been chosen is called “Outlaw Christian: Finding Authentic Faith By Breaking the Rules” by Jacqueline Bussie. The author talks about 6 “unspoken” rules that often govern the life of a person in faith, and tells the reader the rules should be broken. They include things like “never get angry at God” or “never doubt”. Interested? Let the office know or sign up on the sheet available in the narthex. Once we know who’s interested, groups will be formed based on meeting times. The goal is to have the groups get started in October, so sign up today! (An added note to MSM parents – Pastor Trish uses some of Bussie’s work in one of the units she is teaching later this fall. Perhaps a few of you might like to meet on a Wednesday evening while your student is in class!)

Thursday Evening Bible Study

The Thursday evening Bible study will begin again on **Thursday, September 21st at 5:00 pm**. This group welcomes new members at any time! We use a video based curriculum which means we watch a video together – usually about 20 minutes in length, and then discuss what we’ve heard and learn. Some interesting discussions always ensue; and there is no prep or homework involved! We will begin this fall with a study titled “Is this the Time? Interpreting the Mystery of Revelation”. If you’ve ever wanted to better understand this last book of scripture, now’s a great time! Join us at any time in the Gathering Place.

Sunday School and MSM Updates

Sunday School Teachers Still Needed

Messiah is committed to sharing the love of Jesus with people of all ages. In order to continue the good works, we are asking the congregation to serve as teachers, co-teachers, and volunteers to provide hands-on lessons. Curriculum, supplies and support from Heather and Amy are provided. See below for some common questions that might help you decide if volunteering is for you:

WHO CAN VOLUNTEER?

ANYONE can volunteer as a teacher or classroom helper. ANYONE who enjoys spending time with children and watching them learn and grow. You do NOT need to have children in the Sunday School program. Middle school and high school students can volunteer too.

WHAT IF I DON'T KNOW ALL THE ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS CHILDREN MIGHT ASK?

That's A-okay! You do NOT need to know all the answers children might have. Heather, Amy, Pastor Trish, and other teachers can help you find the answers. We all have things to learn.

DO I HAVE TO TEACH EVERY WEEK?

Ideally, being in the classroom each week helps you and the children connect. With that said, we know you have other commitments as well. Communication with Heather and Amy is key, when you know you'll be gone, so we can find a substitute. Or perhaps you and a friend could co-teach and have a rotation schedule, so each of you could regularly have time off.

We provide a schedule of all the lessons and a list of days off, at the beginning of the year so you can plan ahead.

HOW MUCH OF MY TIME DOES IT TAKE?

The step-by-step teacher packet will be supplied to you in advance so you can review at your leisure or arrive a little early on Sunday morning to review before the children arrive. After that, it's 1 hour (9:15—10:15) most Sundays from mid-September to mid-May. Heather and Amy gather all the supplies so you just follow along in the teacher lesson plans provided.

From the Church Council ...

—August Highlights—

Stewardship & Finance: As of July 31, contributions are at 56% of budget compared to 55% for the last two years average. Our year-to-date income is \$18,810 behind expenses compared to \$18,705 last year and an average of \$13,957 for the past 2 years. Year-to-date, we have spent \$19,660 on snow removal compared to an average of \$7,192 for the last 2 years.

The new cooling unit was approved for the pastor's office and has been installed. Tax credits received in July are going towards capital improvements. Pastor Trish organized an adult form on giving with your 401k/IRA which is set for October 1st. A new small group book study was introduced to begin in October. There was discussion on raising the scholarship amounts so more to come next month and possibly having 3 Christmas Eve worships this year instead of 2.

Next council meeting will be Tuesday, September 12th at 6:00 pm.
