

Sacred Sites Tour Opportunity—Update with Pics?



18 Messiah members and friends experienced the Sacred Sites Tour offered through the Minnesota Council of Churches on Friday, Aug 16th. Rev. Jim Bear Jacobs led us through powerful stories and difficult truths about the land beneath our feet. The first stop on the tour is Bdote (where the Minnesota River meets the Mississippi River), which is a sacred place for Dakota people. The second stop is Fort Snelling State Park. This location along the river is where the Dakota origin story begins, but it is also where hundreds of native elders, women, and children were held captive and died in the mid-1800s. The final stop is Pilot Knob Preservation Area, a traditional Dakota burial ground that was slated to be developed into luxury condos in 2006. Fortunately,

development was blocked by indigenous activists and suburban women. If anyone missed the tour and would like to attend, MN Council of Churches also offers them to the public - https://mnchurches.org/what-we-do/healing-minnesota-stories. - A Message from Interim Pastor Tim McDermott -

Dear Partners,

Back in 2003, Lisa and I had several hurdles to jump as Lisa wound down her pregnancy with Madeline and Bronwyn. I remember 28 weeks, 32 weeks, and 34 weeks all being important milestones to our physician. "The longer you can keep them (the twins) inside, the better off they will be," Dr. Bill would tell us. But the most important goal to our friend and doctor was making 36 weeks. Lisa delivered at 37 and a half weeks. The girls were healthy and well! I share this because I can still remember the waiting. The last four to six weeks seemed long to me but interminable to Lisa who was on bed rest for the last four weeks of her pregnancy. She was betwixt and between discomfort and boredom all while doing everything she could to keep the girls in the womb as long as possible. It worked out just fine. In a sense, we (Messiah Lutheran Church) are "great with child" in September of 2024. The long year of waiting (Pastor Trish left Messiah in October 2023) is almost over. The Messiah Call Committee received a list of potential pastoral candidates in June. They interviewed several of these candidates in late June and July. From this list of excellent candidates, the Call Committee has chosen a smaller number of select and highly qualified candidates for second interviews. These meetings are scheduled for the end of August. Eventually the Call Committee will feel confident about one candidate to serve as the resident pastor of our parish. We may not have to wait much longer before the Call Committee feels confident in presenting this highly qualified candidate to the congregation. And if the congregation affirms this candidate (in a Call Meeting of the Congregation), then Messiah will begin its preparations to welcome its new resident (settled) pastor. It is such an exciting time for us!

But still we wait. And waiting is not always easy - even if it is the right thing to do! Lisa did her part by going (and staying) on bed rest for weeks. What can we do? Pray. First, pray for the members of our Call Committee.* Next, pray for potential candidates (even though we don't know their names.) Third, pray that the Holy Spirit would guide and bless the call process so that we take as much time as we need to find the proper candidate to lead this great congregation into our future ministry in this community.

In God's time, the good and great news that we have a candidate the Call committee wishes to present to the congregation will arrive. I can hardly wait, but I am sure that prayerful waiting serves our congregation best. Please join me in prayerful anticipation of the "safe delivery" of the woman or man God has chosen to be our next pastor. It was worth the wait for Lisa and me back in 2003. It is worth it for Messiah in 2024.

MESSIAH'S KIDS on Sundays

Religious Education for Pre-K (3 years old) to Third Grade

- Families will come to 10:30 worship together
- Children will be dismissed with education leaders after Children's Talk (about 15 minutes after church begins)
- 3. Parents can continue to worship until end of service at approximately 11:30
- 4. Parents pick up children from classrooms after worship.

CLUB MESSIAH on Wednesdays

Religious Education for Fourth and Fifth Grade

- 1. Families are invited to come to dinner from 5:30-6:00 pm
- 2. Families will worship together from 6:00—6:30 pm
- 3. Children will have their lesson from 6:30—7:00 pm

Sunday School Parents—we are still looking to add more adults leaders to make this a successful program. Ideally we would like enough adult leaders willing to commit to a schedule on a regular basis—this could mean weekly, biweekly, monthly, etc. Having more adult volunteers allows everyone the flexibility to alternate days they volunteer to lesson the overall commitment. We need your help on both Sundays and Wednesdays to be able to continue this program. Here are the positions we are needing to fill.

- Adult Teachers: You will build relationships to last a lifetime with your students as you learn & grow in faith together. You can team with another teacher for flexibility of schedules. All materials are provided, and you will be supported by coordinators. Reviewing the pre-provided lesson plans only takes about 15 minutes and can be done at home or directly before class begins.
- Adult Teacher Substitutes: you will cover for an Adult Teacher who is unable to teach on a particular day. You will get a glimpse of the "a-ha!" moments our children experience when finding God in their lives and the world around them. All materials are provided, and you will be supported by coordinators. Reviewing the pre-provided lesson plans only takes about 15 minutes and can be done at home or directly before class begins.
- Youth Volunteers: You'll see the growth of faith through the eyes of a child as you support students and teachers. No preparation is needed and schedule can be flexible.
- **Education Office Helper:** You will help gather supplies for future class sessions and other miscellaneous tasks. This is something you will be trained how to do and is a more flexible role. (currently this role has been filled)

Those who have volunteered or are interested, the Education Team will meet with Teachers/Leaders/Volunteers on Wednesday, September 11th from 6:00-6:30 pm to get to know each other, to go over how the year ahead looks and the new curriculum.

COUNCIL UPDATES

From Stewardship and Finance: We are at 54.6% of budget compared to 56.1% last year. Our giving is \$11,600 behind last year, but our expenses are \$18,000 less mainly due to the difference in snow removal. Let's make sure we are keeping up with our pledges and other giving. Remember, you are able to use the following methods of giving:

- 2. Simply Giving (credit card or checking account accepted)
- 4. Put your dollars in the Sunday worship plate

Church Council met on August 11th and the following was discussed:

- Upcoming office changes discussed as Jan prepares to retire on October 31st and Amy will transition to Office Manager. Jan's retirement recognition will be on Sunday, October, 27th during both worship services.
- Further discussions on the physical needs of the church were discussed along with ideas on how to fund those needs. It was also learned that the air conditioner in the conference room needs to be replaced.
- The Call Committee has selected candidates to come for a 2nd interview.

The next council meeting will be held September 15th at 11:30 am.
