- A Message from Pastor Trish -

September 11 – it will be a very busy day at Messiah, and you don't want to miss it! Events that day are an outgrowth of some of the planning church leaders did earlier this summer as we set out an "annual roadmap" for the coming year. We've designated the day "HopeComing Sunday" – a play on the traditional "homecoming" that happens each fall as we return to new activities and routines, with a reminder that "hope" will be our focus in the coming months. So, what can you expect? In addition to a service with a theme of hope, there will be opportunity to care for yourself and receive flu and/or covid vaccines. For families, it's a chance to get registered for the upcoming year of Sunday School. For all of us, it's a chance to join together with friends and neighbors to complete a service project – we will be assembling the personal care kits for which we have been collecting donations and packing them to be sent to places of needs (the project is suitable for ALL ages and abilities!).

There's one more opportunity that day that I especially want to highlight....many if not all of our ministries and activities here at Messiah will have representation and/or displays highlighting the multi-faceted work and fellowship that goes on here each week. This is your chance to check it all out – maybe you will learn about something new, or become reacquainted with ministries you had forgotten about after the pandemic put a temporary halt on everything. But most importantly, here's hoping that you discover something that you want to know more about and start helping with/doing/attending! As part of the day, make sure you pick up and complete an "Opportunities for the Heart" form.

Someone from another congregation told me just the other day that their pastor stood up in church one Sunday and said "I wish that everyone here, all the disciples in this ministry, would commit to doing one thing for or in this congregation in addition to weekly worship." I remember having a similar discussion with the call committee before coming here. Is it possible to make such a thing happen? We won't know unless we ask – so consider this the "ask"!

No matter what your skills or interests, I am CONFIDENT that there's something at Messiah <u>for</u> you but also something for which we <u>NEED</u> you. Want a sample list? How about gardening, helping with mailings, or attending a Bible Study (no experience necessary, no homework required)? Kitchen help, Sunday School helper, teacher or organizer. Middle School chaperone, money counter, altar guild, reader, running the live stream or the screens during worship. Or there's lawn mowing, property maintenance, quilting, prayer shawls, or preschool pillows. Don't forget our social ministry items – preparing and serving meals at a variety of non-profits, organizing a mission trip or work project, spearheading a donation drive, helping with a

fundraiser. Interested in council leadership? Helping with a blood drive? Singing in the choir? There is a place for you and a task for you and WE NEED YOU! Imagine what we could do if EVERYONE committed to doing one new thing in the coming year!? Are you up to the challenge? Want to know more? Join us on September 4th as we Worship United at 10:00 am for a special service of blessings. We will worship outdoors (weather permitting) for the last time in 2022. Let's take a moment to bless our pets, our children and educators, our health, our prayer shawls, to dedicate trees given in memory of Rita Halstead, and remember our baptisms.

HopeComing Sunday—September 11, 2022

HopeComing Sunday (aka "Rally Sunday") will be on September 11th. After worship there will be booths with a variety of opportunities for people to learn about and sign up for areas of interest. "Opportunities of the Heart" will be a form available as another way to indicate your interests and areas where you are willing to assist with the life of the community for the benefit of all. Families can also sign their children up for Sunday School which starts on September 18th.

As another part of our "HopeComing Sunday" celebration we will be doing an all-congregation service project for "God's Work Our Hands" – an ELCA day of service also being celebrated on this day. Together, we will assemble Personal Care Kits for Lutheran World Relief. We will continue to collect donations for the kits until the 11th—lightweight dark bath towels, individually wrapped bars of soap, toothbrushes, sturdy combs, and metal nail clippers.

HopeSending Sunday—September 18, 2022

September 18 – HopeSending Sunday. What's that? An opportunity to send "hope" to others through a special offering for scholarships for those attending post-secondary institutions. We established a Messiah Scholarship Fund in 2021, and celebrated the plans of the first recipients this past May. This Sunday will be an opportunity to once again give to that fund, and as we did with our first special offering in 2021, we will be inviting giving both for students who are members of Messiah but also students of color from MN who are attending a post-secondary school in Minnesota. In this way we are caring for one another within our walls as well as sending love and support to those outside our walls. The offering will once again be split 50/50 between the Messiah Scholarship Fund and the Page Education Foundation. Thursday Evening Bible Study Begins September 15

As a result of that day, Messiah is hosting an additional information and brainstorming session for interested parties to come together and discuss/discern possibilities for helping immigrants or refugees in this community and area. A note from Pastor Trish ...

If you missed my announcement at worship services on August 28, a note about some medical treatment I am undergoing this fall. Thanks to a routine mammogram, I was diagnosed with what appears to be early stage breast cancer, and I am undergoing surgery on September 2. I anticipate taking a week or so off work, and am grateful to Messiah members covering for me in my absence! After recovery from surgery I expect to be undergoing 4-5 weeks of radiation, along with a long stint of hormone therapy. Any need for chemotherapy will be determined after additional testing on the tumor after its removal. I am grateful for the many medical advances for breast cancer that have been made in recent years and I anticipate and pray for a full recovery. I am also grateful for your support and prayers during this time. I am planning to work as close to a regular schedule as possible during these next several weeks, but will also heed the advice of many to practice good self-care, so thank you in advance for your understanding, support and patience.
