A Fresh Start provides new home essentials for those emerging from homelessness. The white donation box will be out in the narthex for those who want to contribute.



## - A Message from Interim Pastor Tim McDermott -

Dear Partners in Christ:

"So, what are you going to do now that you don't have to do anything?"

Professor Gerhard O. Forde taught Reformation Studies to a generation of students at Luther Seminary. After clearly articulating that salvation is a gift from God (which we cannot do anything to earn or deserve), Dr. Forde would ask his students, "So what are you going to do now that you don't have to do anything?"

I believe that this is a question worth contemplating as we observe Lent in 2024. Beginning on Ash Wednesday (February 14) and continuing through five Wednesdays in Lent (concluding on March 20), we will explore some answers to Forde's question. Here is the outline:

#### From Salvation to Sanctity: The Way of the Cross for 21st Century Christians

Subtitle: What are you going to do now that you don't have to do anything to be saved?

Each Wednesday (after Ash Wednesday) we will sing Marty Haugen's beautiful *Holden Evening Prayer*. In the midst of the meaningful Vespers liturgy, we will turn to the overarching question, "What are you going to do now?" Our focus begins with the gift of <u>Salvation</u>, moves to consideration of the meaning of <u>Church</u> in our daily lives, then considers Jesus' call to all the baptized to take up the cross of <u>Discipleship</u>, then explores God's desire that we do what we pray ("<u>Your will be done</u> on earth as it is in heaven" – Lord's Prayer), and concludes with St. Paul's admonition: "This is the will of God: your <u>Sanctification</u>" (1 Thessalonians 4:3).

While this may sound "heady," it is important that the post-Pandemic church consider these subjects. Many people want to know what is it that God is asking of us after God has saved us. I invite you to set aside these Wednesdays (6:30 p.m.) in this Lent 2024 to consider Who is God calling us to be? and What is God calling us to do? I really hope to see you there.

## **Transition Team Plan / Call Process Update**

The Transition Team (whose primary focus is to enable the Messiah community to articulate our strengths, weaknesses, and ministry opportunities) will be established in early February. The Transition Team will interact with congregational members to enable the publication of the Ministry Site Profile (affirmed by the congregation on May 19) which will be made available to all pastors interested in serving Messiah.

The Call Committee will be appointed by the Church Council in mid-April. Having received (May) a list of potential candidates (who meet our desires and expectations as presented in the MSP), the Call Committee will select several candidates to interview in June and July. Second interviews with highly qualified candidates will occur in July and August. A preferred candidate will be presented to the congregation at a Call Meeting in August or September. If the congregation votes to call that pastor, he or she will arrive in September or October.

Please pray for both the Transition Team and the Call Committee. This is spiritual work.

## **Scholarship Application Information**

This will be the second year in which the congregation of Messiah will be giving a scholarship to any member of the congregation attending post-secondary education. Please remember, scholarships are not just for our high school seniors — anyone attending or planning to attend a post-secondary institution in 2024 is eligible. The scholarship is a \$250 award, renewable for up to four years/\$1000 total.

#### **REQUIREMENTS FOR FIRST YEAR RECIPIENTS**

- Must be a confirmed member of Messiah Lutheran Church.
- Have completed 25 hours of volunteer work in the church or community. See list of approved activities.
- Be attending an accredited college, university, or technical college.

#### **REQUIREMENTS FOR SECOND YEAR RECIPIENTS**

Write a 250-500 statement highlighting what you like about Messiah Lutheran Church and any suggestions on how to make the church experience more rewarding.

#### **PROCESS**

- Submit application & volunteer form or essay by March 1, 2024 to the office or a member of the Scholarship Committee.
- Notification of awards will be by May 1, 2024.
- Recognition of awards will be on Graduation Recognition Sunday.
- Scholarship is distributed after successful completion of the fall semester at the approved post-secondary institution. Submit unofficial transcript by December 31, 2024.

# COUNCIL UPDATES

Stewardship & Finance: Another giant thank you to all members and friends of Messiah who pledged and/or contributed to our mission and it's wonderful ministries! We ended 2023 at 99.8% of budget. However, our expenses did outpace donations by \$9737, mainly due to our snow removal costs being \$8000 more than the previous year.

The annual meeting was held on Sunday, January 28, 2024 preceded by a light luncheon. There was discussion of old and new business as well as council and other churchwide positions were voted on. The annual meeting had not yet taken place at the time of this printing, so we'll update you on decisions in the March newsletter.


