- A Message from Interim Pastor Tim McDermott -

Dear Partners in the Gospel,

Transition. Webster's Dictionary defines transition as "passing from one condition, or state of being to another." The opposite of transition is described with words like stability, constancy, or durability.

Messiah Lutheran is in a state of transition. Transition from what or to what you may ask? The easy answer is that we are between pastors. In the interim (after the previous pastor has left and before the new pastor arrives), we have an interim pastor. That's me.

As one who has been trained as a transitional pastor, I hope that in our time together we can do more than just find and call a new, permanent (often called a "settled") pastor. Congregations that want to get through the process as quickly as possible form a Call Committee, select candidates, interview those candidates, and then call the new pastor. Often, according to a scholar of transition ministry, Norman B. Bendroth, the most charismatic candidate gets the job. When the new pastor arrives, the congregation turns to the new leader and asks her or him to "tell us what to do. Tell us how to get things back to normal again." (Interim Ministry in Action, Rowman and Littlefield, 2018).

The problem with that model is that the congregation gives up the ability to decide for itself what changes need to be made. They don't ask: "What ministry opportunities do we wish to pursue? What is God calling us to do and to be in this time of transition and for the foreseeable future?" They assume the new pastor will know the answers to these and similar questions. "The new pastor will tell us what to do." We're all ears.

There is another path through this transition time. We can take a deep dive into Messiah Lutheran's history and study our leadership structure. As a congregation, we can recommit to Messiah's mission, vision, and purpose, and analyze our core values. Most importantly, we can pray, asking God to reveal God's desire and direction for this ministry. Though this process can take a few months if done well, a congregation that follows this path will emerge at a place where the members can call the right pastor for this moment in the church's history and mission. Such a congregation calls a pastor who will help the members achieve their goals and realize their purpose.

It's really up to you. Want to go fast? We can do that. Want to be very intentional about pursuing God's vision for this ministry? We can do that too. But it takes more time. Not years. A few months. At a minimum, our pre-calling activity should answer very precisely three questions: Who are we? Who is our neighbor? What is God calling us to be and to do?

In the course of my two-year training program, I was asked to write my personal vision of transitional ministry:

Because the loss of a pastoral leader can be a painful and sometimes traumatic experience for a congregation, the need for a supportive, strong, and steady hand is crucial for recovery. The task of helping a congregation review its heritage, re-focus or expand its mission, develop strong lay leaders for the present and the future, secure connections with area churches and its judicatory, and envision a bright and meaningful future for itself can be facilitated by an Intentional Interim Pastor (IIP). With nearly forty years of pastoral experience and with the IIP training I am getting, I will be ready to take up this challenge if called to do so.

Whether you choose to go fast or more slowly, I am here to help. I feel very grateful and so honored to be your partner in this important endeavor.

-November Highlights-

Stewardship & Finance: We were blessed with a wonderful October of giving with 5 Sundays including Pastor Trish's farewell service. As of 10/31 donations, we are at 80% of budget having caught back up to the last 2 year's average of 80%. Year to date expenses remain above income by \$18,711 as we hope to catch up these last two months of the year. Current pledges are at \$236,518. Last year's pledges totaled \$251,519 so we have a ways to go with 7 weeks left. Thank you to those who have already pledged, and there is still time for those who haven't to submit your pledge for 2024.

Messiah's new interim pastor started mid-November—please welcome Pastor Tim McDermott.

Decisions regarding a capital campaign for early 2024 are also in progress. An additional group will meet to discuss updates to the Endowment and Scholarship funds. Pastor Tim gave an overview of the transition and call process that he will guide us through.

Next council meeting will be Sunday, December 10th at 11:45 am.


