### Winter Donations—Collecting until February 9th

#### **Connections – Homeless Shelter**

The Connections shelter is an emergency shelter in Mankato that houses men, women, and families. The current needs are: Thinsulate or water-repellent gloves for men and women (size: Medium-Large), wool and/or thermal men's socks. These items need to be new. Also, Cub Foods, Hy-Vee, or Kwik Trip gift cards \$10 each can be put in the Donations box.

### A Fresh Start

A Fresh Start serves those emerging from homelessness. This can be gently used or new: Kitchen dishes and utensils, bath towels, bedding blankets, comforters, furniture, etc. This year we are also going to focus on: toilet paper, paper towels, brooms/dustpans, plungers, multi-surface cleaners, laundry baskets and garbage cans.



Opportunities exist to make a meal and serve at the Connections Shelter. Please see sign-up sheets for March 3rd & 4th in the narthex, the 2 weeks leading up to the serve dates. If you are unable to help make, serve, or deliver food, please consider a donation to purchase the food.



Messiah will serve at Crossroads again on February 18th. This time we are asking 4 different people to make a hotdish. The recipe and ingredients will be provided. We will also need additional food items: dessert and rolls. Sarah will be in the narthex for the next couple of weeks to sign-up for the above, as well as for volunteers to serve.

# **Cruz Family Celebration and Fundraiser**

In April, the WELCOME Team, in partnership of 5 local Lutheran churches, is sponsoring a celebration of the Ariac and Andrea Cruz family's many achievements since arriving in MN from Nicaragua 2 years ago seeking asylum. The celebration will include a dinner, music, a short program and a Silent Auction. The funds raised will support the family's quest for asylum which is a long, complicated and expensive process. Messiah has been asked to provide at least 5 themed packages/ baskets to support this fundraiser. We are seeking donations for these, either new items or money to be used to purchase themed items. We would love to have creative people to join us in this effort. In addition, if any of you have a connection to businesses that may be willing to donate money or items (cash, gift cards, tickets, or physical items) we would appreciate that as well--ask us for further information about that. We hope to have items gathered by the end of February or early March, then get together to put the packages together. ### - A Message from LaDonna Thomas -

Dear Beloved People of Messiah,

#### **Remember these?**

They are some of the stars distributed in worship in early January. They were part of our last celebration of the Christmas season, the visit of the wise men to the infant Jesus. The wisemen followed a star to the place where Jesus was. They were drawn to the feet of Jesus by a star shining brightly in the night sky. The star revealed the Christ child.

A few hundred years later, there were people who moved to the middle eastern desert where, removed from the hustle and bustle of daily life, they sought to draw close to God. Their life was an ascetic one: simple, uncomplicated, prayerful.



They became known as the Desert Fathers and Mothers, from whom we have received a wealth of insight and wisdom for growing a spiritual life.

Others who desired closeness with God, but who could not leave their daily life of family and work sometimes went out to the desert fathers and mothers to receive their wisdom and instruction for tending to the inner life of faith. They would often ask of the desert fathers and mothers: "Give us a word or a phrase." The word or phrase would then become a focus for their meditation and prayer life when they returned to their daily life. People received them as gifts. It was assumed the word or phrase was sacred and came bearing some kind of gift that each needed. People would live with their word or phrase for a period of time or perhaps even a year to see what it might offer them for the growth of their spiritual life.

We practiced a similar thing with the "star words" many of you received in worship on January 5th. The word I received was "prayer." It's a word that may sound obvious for a pastor. Indeed prayer is a part of my daily spiritual practice. But receiving the word "prayer" has made me notice the ways prayer is a part of not just a morning ritual, but it is infused throughout my day. For example, I hear a disturbing, worrisome piece of news and my star word "prayer" invites me lay that burden at the feet of God. Or, I fret about how a confirmation lesson will connect with the youth and my star word invites me, through prayer, to seek God's help. And just the other day I was feeling a bit dry in my practice of prayer, a bit stuck in old patterns that no longer brought life or joy. Then came a friends invitation to join a group she is facilitating on prayer through movement of the body. My star word gave me the courage to sign up.

If you received a star word in our early January worship and you kept it, how is it connecting with your inner spiritual life? What gifts is it giving to you? How is it leading you to God? I'd love to chat with you about your experience or exchange a text or email around this practice of receiving and living with your "word."
