

- A Message from LaDonna Thomas -

Dear Beloved People of Messiah,

Before I moved to Mankato, I lived on the North Shore of Boston, right on the Atlantic Ocean. Living in the presence of such a rugged, voluminous, vast, watery creation was a new experience for me. I grew up thousands of miles from and only visited one for the first time as a young adult. As beautiful as the Ocean on the North Shore was, I really had to befriend it. The noise of the waves and the uncontrollable way they crashed into the shoreline at their own pace and rhythm at high and low tide was overwhelming to me, at first. I often felt more of a threat from the ocean than the typical, relaxing feeling many get, especially from tropical beaches.

One of my parishioners would regularly ask me, "Have you been to the ocean today?" She often made comments about how healing the water, the shoreline, and the ocean air were. She encouraged me week by week, month by month, to go to the water, regularly and often.

She was right. As I visited the ocean waters as often as I could, I could sense there was something happening deep inside of me. Relaxation? Yes. Renewal? Yes. A heightened awareness of the Spirit of the the creator? Yes. Healing? Yes. And, more than those things, was this sense of awe... awe at the power of the waves, awe at the beauty in the water at sunrise and sunset... awe at the gifts in the water the fish that supported the local economy and the dancing joy of whales and seals. Awe that I was caught up in a life-giving ecology that reflected and connected me with God and God's creative work.

One could say that my time of living with the ocean, transformed me in to a purveyor of awe. A purveyor is one who collects or warehouses something. Beginning at the water's edge and expanding to many other times and places, I am becoming a purveyor of awe. And, from that storehouse of awe flows the fruits of God's Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, gentleness, generosity, faithfulness and self-control.



There is much around each of us, wherever we live, to stir up experiences of awe and with them, our connection to our awesome God. I experience a similar kind of awe and its spiritual gifts in other ways, like a walk in the woods, the joyful interaction between a parent and a child, watching the tender care of a man for his aging and ill partner, in the dance of a young ballerina, in music, in the smell of a campfire, the sight of acres and acres of rich black Minnesota soil, and the list goes on and on.

During the months of July and August, in our Sunday worship services, we will explore this sense of awe and wonder and its connection to our relationship with God and God's world, especially the gifts it can bring as we live in a time of challenge, change, discouragement, and uncertainty. We'll explore how God's gift of awe can anchor us in God's abiding love and grace.

We'll also supplement the Sunday worship experiences with a mid-week experience of wonder and awe. "Wonder-Full Wednesdays" evenings will offer, on alternating weeks, 1) brief walks in nature as a place to receive and collect experiences awe and 2) an introduction of the spiritual practice of centering or meditative prayer. Watch the weekly announcements for more information.

I hope and pray you have and AWEsome summer! Together, let's become purveyors of awe and connection to God. Gratefully,

COUNCIL UPDATES

2025 council members: Janet Jones, Nate Brekke, Jean Zandstra, Katie Hendrickson, Dustin Runkle, Swede Mundell, Julie Olsen and Greg Suskovic.

Through April, 2025 our tithes and offerings equal \$128,795 compared to \$122,967 this time last year.

Expenses are at \$119,300 vs. \$115,957 in 2024. Snow removal accounts for most of the increase.

As always, we are grateful to God for what he has first given us and Messiah's response to his graciousness.

Church Council met on May 21st and the following was discussed:

- Following positive feedback from the congregation, quotes are being obtained to proceed with a Capital Campaign.
- Dustin Runkle will lead the Property Team volunteers needed to mow the lawn; please call the office to volunteer.
- Be cautious in North parking lot due to a hole near the drain. Cones mark the area, and the council is addressing it.
- The water fountain will be replaced by a new water fountain and bottle filler.
- Outdoor worships are scheduled, but assistance is needed for setup/takedown. Please prayerfully consider helping with this; it will involve only 3 Sundays during the summer.
- Messiah will begin an internal audit soon.
- The possibility of allowing donations and purchases via Venmo is being explored.

The next council meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, June 11th at 6:30 pm.
